Green Commissioning

- 1. Identify items for environmental protection (Check the level of greeness)
- 2. Energy consumption data collection (Calculate the amount of CO₂ emissions)
- 3. Conduct hearing with the management (Understand operational situation and environmental measures in the operation)
 - 4. On-site measurement

(Indoor Environment: Temperature and humidity, air flow, illumination, VOC, etc.)
(System performance: Heat loss, voltage drop, etc.)
